NOTE FOR SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

2. The article should be about 4000 to 5500 words; Book review articles should not be more than 1000 words.
3. An abstract (in English) not exceeding 250 words should be included
4. Two hard copies of the articles are to be submitted. The disc copy would be made later, using Microsoft Word or WordPerfect for Windows programme.
5. The cover page should indicate the title, the author's name, e-mail, and address to which vetted papers are to be sent.
6. As much as possible, footnotes should be avoided
7. References should be arranged alphabetically and placed at the end of the article using the latest APA format (7th edition)
8. All contributors will receive a copy of the issue number in which their article appeared. They should therefore endeavor to inform the managing editor of any change in their address. All other member to the paper will pay for their copies if they are interested at N10,000 per copy, excluding postage cost.
